

Harris-Stowe State University Faculty Senate Elections, Spring 2014

The Harris-Stowe State University Faculty Senate welcomed its new and returning members at its April 11, 2014 meeting. These senators were elected from the College of Arts & Sciences, the College of Education, and the Anheuser-Busch School of Business, and serve as representatives for the entire membership of the university's forty-eight regular, full-time faculty. The three year terms noted are new members of the Senate. Other representatives are continuing to serve their terms according to the Senate's By-laws:

At the April 11th meeting new officers were elected: Dr. Odesa Weatherford-Jacobs is the President of the Faculty Senate; Dr. Owolabi Tiamiyu is the Vice President; Kenneth Bowman is the Liaison to the Missouri Association of Faculty Senates. They replace the outgoing executive board, which consisted of President Dr. Johndavid Kerr, Vice-President Dr. Weatherford-Jacobs, and Secretary Mary Pier.

Dr. Johndavid Kerr has been elected to a state-wide, executive office as President of the Missouri Association of Faculty Senates. As President, he has created the office of Liaison to the MAFS from each member University to assist in efforts to work with the state on issues affecting Missouri universities and colleges. His executive board consists of Vice-President Tony Lupo (University of Missouri-Columbia), Secretary-Treasurer Bob Bergland (Missouri Western State University), and Member-at-Large Max Fridell (Northwest Missouri State University).
